

CHILD'S PONCHO



Here's the pattern.... (probably for a child aged 3-5 ish)

You will need:

2 100g skeins of Araucania Azapa (I used colour 810)
5.5mm needles

Main poncho pattern: (make 2 pieces)

Cast on 45 st

Knit 6 rows

Row 1: Knit

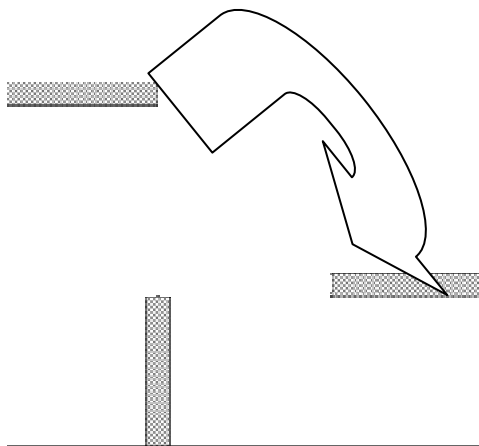
Row 2: K3 purl to last 3 sts K3

Repeat rows one and two until about 106 rows are completed

Knit 6 rows

Cast off

Sew the pieces up as per:



The hash areas indicate the sewn up bits!!

I then embellished the front collar area with some little crocheted flowers!!

I used a couple of bits of stashed yarns and crocheted the apple blossoms from [Lesley Stanfield's 100 Flowers to Knit and Crochet](#)
